A SG is a diverse, interdisciplinary group of 6-7 cleft professionals convened to explore a key pandemic-related challenge facing LMIC contexts. Each SG will facilitate a 75 minute Roundtable at the *S4CCC : COVID & Beyond* conference.

- Diverse participation: *interdisciplinary with an LMIC focus*
- Emphasis upon documenting and disseminating *practical* tools

SG Process:

In light of the pandemic, explore:

- *Who can we **talk to** about what is being implemented in LMIC and beyond in response?*
 - *What might the **literature** suggest about the opportunities and challenges of these approaches?*
 - *What **questions** do we want to discuss and explore further ?*
 - *What **recommendations** or **practical tools** can we offer to CCC professionals in LMIC?*
- **Present** findings + **facilitate** a Roundtable discussion on June 2, 2021
